Release of funds under Major Head 2236-Nutrition (Budget Estimates) Administrative Department's Order No. SWD-Acctts/D-18/(ICDS)2015-16

dated 05.08.2015

ORDER No: 370 -SMD- of 2016 DATED: 15 -01- 2016

Sanction is hereby accorded to release of additional funds for the financial year 2015-16 to the tune of Rs.771.09 lacs (Rupees Seven Crore, Seventy One lac and Nine thousand) only and placement of the same at the disposal of District Programme Officers of Jammu /Kashmir Province for its further placement to concerned CDPOs of their respective districts for meeting the expenditure on account of Honorarium to Anganwadi Workers/ Anganwadi Helpers under the scheme ICDS (General) during the current financial year. The release of funds is subject to following conditions:-

- 1. The expenditure shall be made strictly as according to the classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department. No omissions/commissions or diversions shall be made under any pretext unless specifically and separately authorized.
- 2. The DPOs/CDPOs will ensure that the honorarium released for the AWWs/AWHs is transferred to the Bank Accounts of the AWWs/AWHs within 10 days from the issuance of this order. The entire amount of monthly honorarium, comprising centre share, state share, and additional contribution from state amounting to Rs.3600/-, 3650/- and Rs.3700/- for an AWW and Rs.1840/- for AWH is to be paid in a single installment to each AWW/AWH as per the norms.
- 3. Treasury Officers shall not entertain bills without complete classification under which funds have been placed with the Treasury.
- 4. There should be expenditure under each object head to avoid rush of expenditure during the last quarter of the financial year.
- 5. DDOs shall complete all the codal formalities before presentation of bills at the Treasury.
- 6. All the controlling officers shall be duty bound to ensure submission of revenue and expenditure statements to the Finance Department on monthly basis.
- 7. All the controlling officers/DDOs shall conduct periodic reconciliation of remittance and drawals with the treasury and the office of the Accountant General (A&E) J&K to ensure correct reflection of income and expenditure in the Finance and other Accounts.
- 8. All the sanctions/approvals and clearance should be in place before drawal of money from the treasury.
- 9. The Expenditure on this account is debitable to the following head:-




