

Invitation of Quotations

On behalf of Nutrition Procurement Committee Rural/Urban rates are hereby invited from registered Super Bazars/Cooperative Stores Situated in District Baramulla /Registered local shopkeepers (within the jurisdiction of Poshan Project Sopore) for supply of below Nutrition Items to AWCs belonging to Poshan Project Sopore District Baramulla under scheme Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP-ICDS) & SAG for 1st quarter 2026-27.

Terms and Conditions:

- I) The quotations in sealed envelope accompanied with the samples of the Nutrition items packed in **transparent jars with seal & stamp** of supplying agency should reach the office of the Child Development Officer, Sopore (Administrator-Procurement Committees-rural/urban) by or before **10th of July-2026, up-to 4.00 PM. No rates will be accepted without sealed samples of the nutrition items.**
- II) The quotations shall be opened on **11th of July-2026, technical evaluations** at 12.30 PM and the **financial evaluation** at 2.00 PM on the same day.
- III) Loose nutrition items like, **Oil, Haldi, Biscuit and salt** are not allowed to deliver at AWC level.
- IV) If the successful bidder fails to deliver the nutrition items at AWC level, then the expenditure incurred for lifting of the nutrition items from the Panchayat to AWC shall be deducted from the bill.
- V) The rates so quoted should be clearly mentioned. Any over writing or discrepancy shall make the quotation liable for disqualification without any further communication in this regard.
The bidder is required to deposit **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) Worth Rs 10000(Ten thousand)** In favour of CDPO-Sopore, failing which bid shall not be accepted. EMD shall be released after opening of tenders, for successful bidder the EMD shall be released after successful completion of contract.
- VI) Registration Documents of the cooperative shall be deposited in the office along with the quotations.
- VII) Cooperatives registered under J&K self-Reliant cooperatives Act 1999 shall be considered only if they receive necessary No objection certificate/ Verification from the Deputy Registrar cooperatives Baramulla in light of the communication No: DRCS/Bla/SS/2023/796-809 Dated 19-7-2023, failing which such cooperatives shall not be considered at all.

- VIII) The cooperative society/Super Bazar/registered local shopkeepers shall agree to abide by all the standing norms issued by the government in this regard from time to time.
- IX) The rates so quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes, freight etc and the nutrition items shall be delivered at AWCs. Further there shall be proper deduction of taxes i- e TDS, SGST, CGST Etc. by the Department at the time of processing of the bills for the expenditure incurred.
- X) In case of any nutrition items has been found **misbranded, substandard, expired or not fit** for human consumption action under **law/rules** shall be initiated against the supplier.
- XI) The bidder should submit rates and other documents in two separate envelopes.
- XII) The procurement of supplementary nutrition shall be made as per the Decentralized Policy for Procurement of Supplementary Nutrition under Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme issued vide Govt. Order No. 44-SW of 2019 dated 29-01-2019 and the terms and conditions mentioned in Mission Director Poshan J&K Order No. 60-MD of 2026 dated 05/02/2026.
- XIII) The funds shall be utilized strictly after fulfilment of the requisite codal/procedural formalities required under the rules/norms.
- XIV) The product should have a detailed description, including required nutritional values, packaging, batch numbers, manufacturing and expiry dates, and all statutory details.
- XV) The items supplied must conform to the specified standards and specifications
- XVI) The supplying agency must supply the nutrition items as per the approved specifications of the item.
- XVII) Brand must be FSSAI-certified/approved/fortified Grade-1, with no compromise on the quality and specifications of the nutrition items.
- XVIII) Payments will be released upon satisfactory delivery of the contracted nutrition items and will be processed through BEAMS (SNA SPARSH).
- XIX) The rates should be inclusive of all taxes, transportation, and associated charges, including freight charges up to the Anganwadi centre level, as the supplier(s) shall deliver the supplies to the Anganwadi centres under proper receipt as per indent.
- XX) At the time of supply, items must have a **shelf life of six months**, except for those items having an approved shelf life below six months (wherein the maximum approved period shall be considered) from the date of receipt at the Anganwadi level.
- XXI) A fine shall be imposed pursuant to the Food Safety and Standards Act of India and rules made thereunder, up to the maximum amount, if any violation of norms and quality is found at any stage.
- XXII) A Bank Guarantee or Security Deposit of 1% of the contracted value shall be deposited or the 1% of total payment shall be kept as security deposit, which shall be released three months after successful completion of supplies at the Anganwadi centre(s) level.. It shall be forfeited if the supplier fails to deliver the supply within the specified period or if the supplies are found substandard/expired.
- XXIII) Nutrition items should be supplied to AWCs within seven (7) days of receiving the supply orders.
- XXIV) The supplier(s) should not be under liquidation, court receivership, or similar proceedings and should not be bankrupt.
- XXV) The supplier(s) shall supply nutritional items along with a quality certificate, and random testing of nutrition items will be conducted by the Food Safety Department at any stage.

- XXVI) The supplier(s) must hold a valid FSSAI License, Trade Certificate/license, and GST Registration. In addition, for co-operatives, a Registration Certificate, approved by laws, and a functionality certificate from the concerned competent authority are required.
- XXVII) The procurement shall be made within the available budget, ensuring that no liabilities are created and financial discipline shall be maintained in letter and spirit.
- XXVIII) The supplier must adhere to all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations, including labour laws and non-discrimination policies, ensuring open and free competition.
- XXIX) The supplier(s) should submit an affidavit, duly attested by a Judicial Magistrate, stating that the firm/supplying agency (Super Bazar/Co-operatives, Stores, fixed price shops/Registered local shopkeepers and others) is not blacklisted by any Govt. or semi-Govt. authority.
- XXX) This office reserves the right to accept / reject or withdraw/cancel the contract with specific reason(s).
